## English Eccentrics: The Sad Joker 悲伤的小丑

William: Unconventional, oddball, peculiar ...

Li: 我的感觉是自古至今的英国怪人还挺多不少的,eccentric!

**William:** Yes, and none more so than the subject of today's programme,

Vivian Stanshall. He was an artist, a poet, a musician, a playwright

and a prankster.

**Li:** A prankster - 爱开玩笑的人,恶作剧的人。

**William:** He described himself as a jester.

Li: A jester - 爱开玩笑的人; 小丑。有意思, 那他到底是个什么样的英国怪人

呢? English Eccentric!

William: My name is William Kremer.

Li: 我是杨莉,大家好。Vivian Stanshall 出生于 1943 年,他的父亲是一家公司

的老板,他先是从一所艺术学校毕业,然后创建了自己的乐队, The Bonzo

Dog Dada Band 后来改名为 The Bonzo Dog Doo-Dah Band.

**William:** The band played jazz and pop music inspired by the 1920s, often

with silly lyrics. One of the members of The Bonzo Dog Doo-Dah

Band was Neil Innes.

Matthew Parris: Describe your first meeting with him.

Neil Innes: Well I was at Goldsmiths Art School. And he came to a pub

on the corner, a big Irish pub, The New Cross Arms. And he was slightly plump in those days and he had Billy Bunter check trousers, a Victorian frock coat, he had violet oval pince-nez glasses and carried a euphonium under his arm. But to top it all off, he had these enormous pink rubber false

ears.



William: Did you hear? Stanshall was wearing enormous pink rubber false

ears

Li: False ears - 假耳朵。 他穿着一条格子花布的裤子 check trousers, a

Victorian frock coat 维多利亚时代男子礼服大衣, pince-nez glasses 老式

无腿眼睛。

**William:** That's a very strange way to dress to go to the pub! Let's hear a bit

more from Neil Innes. You will hear him use two very common

English phrases to describe Vivian Stanshall.

Neil Innes: He would have travelled all the way from where he came

from dressed like that. I mean Viv had a wonderful sense of

humour.

Matthew Parris: Did he ever get beaten up on the underground?

Neil Innes: No, no. I mean there's something about Viv that was you

know larger than life and he always got away with murder.

Li: Neil 在形容 Vivian 的时候说他是个不同凡响的人 larger than life – 这个短

William: Yes, Neil Innes also said "He always got away with murder". Vivian

Stanshall didn't kill anyone! But if you get away with murder that

means that people allow you to do outrageous things.

**William:** The Bonzo Dog Doo-Dah Band became a success.

Li: 1968年,他们的成名作是同著名歌星保罗·麦卡尼联手制作的 'I'm the

urban spaceman', 一曲水管独奏曲,非常轰动,大获成功!

William: In 1970, the band split up. Vivian released some solo records and

went on to develop a comic character called Sir Henry Rawlinson.

Li: 不过 Vivian Stanshall 是个心事重重的人,下面是他的第二个妻子 Ki

Longfellow 的回忆。 What was it that Vivian regretted?

Ki: Vivian regretted not being a painter his entire life; the last

time, one of the last times I ever saw him he was weeping

at his failure.

Matthew Parris: Was that regret right? I mean, could he have been a great

painter?



Ki: Yeah. I do think so.

Neil Innes: I think so too... there's also the kind of occupational hazard

of being a kind of clown, and everybody sort of... you know the depression is there, it's part of it. But what you have to weigh up is the inspired comedy and mirth that he managed to sort of infect us all with, you know. You can't take that

away.

**William:** Ki said that Vivian regretted not becoming a painter. Although he

was a successful musician, that wasn't the success that Vivian wanted. He felt he was a failure. Vivian Stanshall died in 1995 in a

tragic house fire.

Before we finish – let's just test your memory. Can you remember the two phrases that Neil Innes used to describe Vivian Stanshall?
