

审题要点：

一方：international news 设为 subject 的必要性和好处

1. 帮助学生了解各类新闻、具有全球视野
2. 新闻报道需要真实 公正 客观，这一点有助于培养学生的人生观、价值观
3. 有些学校可以借此进一步完善课程体系

另一方：没有必要设置该课程

1. 中学生本来就需要学较多的基础课程，没有太多时间
2. 课程设置没有很强的必要性，如今各类媒体可以提供各种信息，并且很多节

People who call for setting international news as a subject as early as in secondary schools harbor the view that students need to be informed the latest events around the world like violent clashes in the Middle East, political summits in America, and joyful carnivals in Brazil so as to develop a global vision. In the hope of cultivating students' morality in addition to academic knowledge, those advocates are equally allured by the prospect that those basic rules in news reporting-objectivity and fairness-would shape students' outlook on life and the world. Put another way, students afterwards would readily have proper judgment on events around themselves. Also, some schools could take this chance to improve and perfect their curricula by providing students more choices besides common courses like mathematics, history, or PE.
