

When a young child dies, his mother is given an android which looks and behaves exactly like a real boy. The robot loves her like a son.



An ad isn't just colour and pictures. You've got something to say, so the next thing you should do is to decide how much text you should write. Remember that people are impatient and will __78 __ read a long text to see what it's about. The amount of text should be just right to get your message across, so focus on your message and say it with as few words as possible. Your choice of font (the style of letters), font size to read, especially from a distance,

Many people think their brain will slow down with age and their memory will get worse as a result. The






