If you have a chance to visit Canada, you will surely be amazed at its urban(都市的) transportation. Why? Here are the reasons:

All cities and most major towns in Canada have a public transportation system with one or more ways of transportation (bus, subway, train, etc.). The bus is the most common form of urban transportation in Canada. To use public transportation, you must buy a ticket. A transit pass(乘车证) allows you unlimited use of public transportation for a specific period (one month or more). It's usually cheaper than buying a ticket if you plan to use public transportation often.

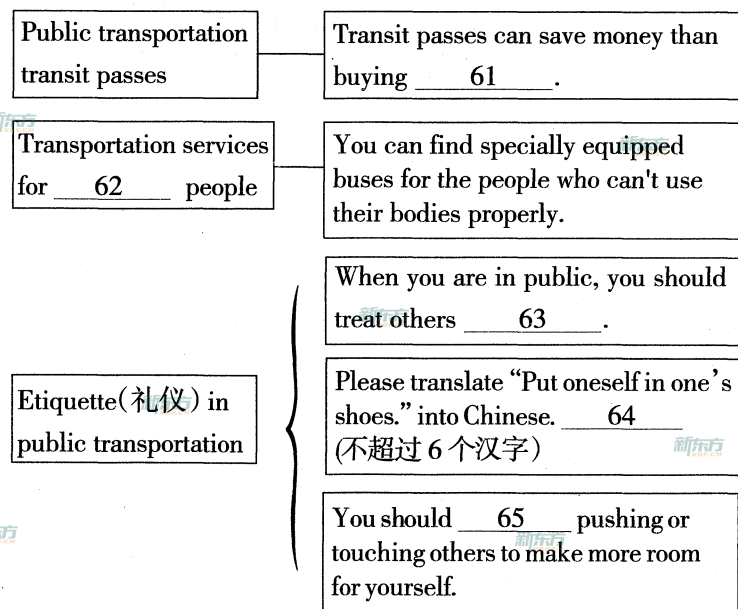
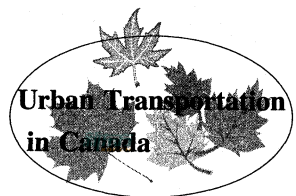
Public transportation in Canada has features to help the people with disability. In many cities and towns, there are transportation services available specifically for people with disability, such as specially equipped buses. You can find out about these services in the same way you would learn more about other public transportation.

When taking public transportation such as a bus or train, it is important to understand the unspoken rules of behavior in the public place. Here are a few things to note:

◆ Be polite to others around you. You'd better treat others in a polite way. For example, keep a proper noise level when talking or making a phone call.

◆ Put oneself in one's shoes. If you are carrying a backpack or a large shoulder bag in a crowded bus, keep it close to you, preferably at your feet. Think about what your feeling is when someone's bag hits you. You should always be considerate of others.

◆ Try not to push or touch others in order to make more room for yourself. Sometimes public transit can become very crowded, but it is important to keep calm.

<p>Coming-of-age events in the US</p> <p>In the US, getting your driver's license at the age of 16 is seen as a major coming-of-age (成人) ceremony.</p> <p>Another big coming-of-age event is the graduation party. Teenagers wear fancy clothing, ask each other to dance.</p> <p>And there's still more. At the age of 18, teenagers can vote (选举) in the US and at 21, they can drink alcohol (酒). This is also the time when most children move out of their parents' home for college or work.</p>	<p>Coming-of-age events in China</p> <p>In China, a person aged 18 or over is an adult. They are allowed to get the driver's license. Legally, they are fully responsible for themselves. And also, they get more rights, like voting.</p>
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It is around this age that society starts to consider us to be adults. But what does it really mean to be an adult?

Psychologist Jeffrey Arnett surveyed young adults and found three common adulthood symbols: taking responsibility for yourself, making independent decisions, and being financially (经济上) independent.

I agree with Arnett. Being an adult has more to do with one's maturity (成熟). If you want to drive, vote, drink, leave home or even start a romantic relationship, you have to make sure that you're ready to be responsible.

<p>Coming-of-age trouble</p> <p>As we grow up, we have to find out who we really are. We have to find a way to fit in and sometimes even build a new life in a new place.</p> <p>The troubles are commonly referred to in works of literature (文学) specifically in "coming of age" novels.</p> <p>The book <i>The Catcher in the Rye</i> by US author J.D. Salinger (1919- 2010) is one of the most famous coming-of-age works. In this book, Holden Caulfield is a sixteen-year-old student. Although he is rich and kind, no one in the school likes to get along with him. Not only does he feel lonely, but also he feels sad about the life. He even wants to escape from the society.</p>

Every year in March, the two sessions (两会) are being held in Beijing. Government officials hold news conferences (新闻发布会) to give 71 to the public. During this time, a lot of people pay attention to China, 72 interpreters (口译员) play a very important role at these news conferences.

Zhang Lu 73 a professional interpreter for more than ten years. She usually interprets for top leaders, 74 Premier Li Keqiang and former Premier Wen Jiabao. Zhang 75 for her translation of Chinese literary quotes (文学典故). How are interpreters like Zhang able to work so correctly and quickly?

Their ability 76 comes from hard work. Most of them majored in English in college and went through lots of training. To be a skillful interpreter, they never stop learning. According to China Radio International, the interpreters won't know who they are going to interpret for 77 a month before the two sessions. They then make full use of the month to prepare everything by 78. They find out famous sentences that the spokesperson might plan to use when they answer questions. They also try 79 what kinds of questions might be asked.

There is no "secret" to be a 80 interpreter. It's all a matter of skill and hard work.
