**Facilities at Beijing Daxing International Airport**

**Mobile Coverage:** All major mobile carriers will be supported at the airport and it will be a key area for new 5G coverage. Chinese SIM cards will be available for sale onsite.

**Leisure areas:** The airport will feature a large traditional Chinese garden area and several lounges.

**Service Building:** This building will be divided into two parts. The northern part will be for hotels while the southern one is for business and office.

**Interesting Facts and Features**

- Minimal Walking Distance —The distance between the transport hub (枢纽) and airport terminal is less than 600 meters or 8 minutes' walk.
- The first luggage item appears on the carousel (传送带) within 13 minutes of landing.
- Superfast transfer times between arrival and boarding.
- You only need to scan your ID or passport and boarding passes are no longer required when you go through the customs.
- Low energy design and use of renewable energy sources.

**Go to / from the Airport****Daxing Airport Express on the Beijing subway**

This new subway line connects the airport to the center area of Beijing.

From Daxing Airport Station to Caoqiao Station will take around 20 minutes.

**Beijing Daxing Airport shuttle bus**

There are six lines running between downtown Beijing and Daxing Airport.

**Beijing - Xiong' an intercity railway**

It starts from Beijing West railway station. It will offer travel time of Beijing CBD (Central Business District) to the airport in about 11 minutes.

**Capital Airport to Beijing New Airport intercity railway connector**

It is a non-stop railway which connects Beijing Capital International Airport to the new airport.

**B**

You can't see your sleeping pet's brain waves, but its behavior can tell you when your cat might be dreaming. If you watch closely, you'll see that as your cat falls asleep, its breathing becomes slow and regular. It has entered the first stage of sleep, called slow-wave sleep. After 15 minutes you'll notice a change in its breathing. Its eyeballs move quickly under its closed eyes. Its paws and whiskers (胡须) move and it shakes an ear. Now it has entered the quick-wave sleep. Generally speaking, "fast eyeball movement" and "fast brain waves" can be considered as the symbols of dreaming. Now messages from its brain to the large muscles in its legs are blocked, so it can't run about. It is in a state of "sleep paralysis."

Back in 1963, Michel Jouvet, a French scientist who was studying sleep in cats, used chemicals and operations to cut off the "brain bridge" of a cat, which interrupted the cat's sleep paralysis. Even though it was completely asleep, the dreaming cat began to chase balls that Jouvet couldn't see and also arched (弓起) its back at invisible enemies. He figured he was watching them act out their dreams!

In another study, scientists recorded rats' brain waves while they learned mazes(迷宫). One day, they left the brain-wave-recording machine on while the rats fell asleep. The pattern of brain waves in the sleeping rats matched the pattern when the rats were in the maze!

Many researchers now think that in both people and animals, one purpose of dreams is to rehearse (彩排) important skills and recent learning. How often animals dream seems to be tied to body size. Cats dream about every 15 minutes, mice every 9 minutes, and elephants every 2 hours. And though cows and horses usually sleep standing up, they only dream when lying down.
