



Clara Daly was sitting on an Alaska Airlines flight from Boston to Los Angeles when a flight attendant (空乗) asked a question over the loudspeaker: "Does anyone on board know American Sign Language?" Clara, 15, at that time, pressed the call button.

The flight attendant came by and explained the situation. "We have a passenger on the plane who's blind and deaf," she said. The passenger seemed to want something, but he was traveling alone and the flight attendants couldn't understand what he needed. Clara had been studying American Sign Language (ASL) for the past year and knew she'd be able to communicate with the man. So she <u>unbuckled</u> her seat belt, walked toward the front of the plane, and knelt by the seat of Tim Cook, who was 64 then.

Gently taking his hand, she signed, "How are you? Are you OK?" Cook asked for some water. When it arrived, Clara returned to her seat. She came by again a bit later because he wanted to know the time. On her third visit, she stopped and stayed a while. "He didn't need anything. He was lonely and wanted to talk," Clara says. So for the next hour, that's what they did. She talked about her family and her plans for the future. Cook told Clara how he had gradually become blind over time and shared stories of his days as a traveling salesman. Even though he couldn't see her, she looked at his face smiling with such kindness.

"Clara was amazing," a flight attendant told Alaska Airlines in a blog interview. "You could tell Cook was very excited to have someone he could speak to, and she was such an angel."



Perhaps more than any other kind of jobs, creative ideas are expected to develop in brainstorming(头脑风暴). 但头脑风暴真的是一种解决创造性问题的好方法吗? In the creative world, it seems that working together is important to bring an idea to life. However, it is not good for shaping ideas in the first place.

WeTransfer did its survey called Ideas Report, with 20,000 creatives in 197 countries and regions showing how they develop ideas after inspiration(灵感) stops.



If we give people enough time and space to think, they will come up with better ideas. However, employees in most companies often have many meetings scheduled and have no chance to prepare their thoughts, which makes them short of new ideas.

Spending time alone to think will help you come up with your own ideas and develop independent thinking. This is important when you're making decisions. It seems we need to rethink the way we work and play, especially how we spend time at school and at home.

#### Brainstorming

Alex Osborn, a US advertising expert, came up with the idea of brainstorming in his book Applied Imagination: Principles and Procedures of Creative Problem — Solving in 1953.

Brainstorming encourages people to come up with ideas that can, at first, seem a bit crazy. Some of these ideas can be crafted (加工) into creative solutions to a problem, while others can think about even more ideas. It also creates a free and open environment for everyone to take part in. It helps them come up with creative ideas if they are fully prepared. Even if it doesn't result in a useful solution, it can still help team members get together.


