	<p>Liu Hulan was born in Wenshui, Shanxi and joined the Party in 1946. To support the army, she offered food, passed secret messages and so on. On January 12, 1947, at the age of 14 years old, she was killed by the enemy for she refused to betray(背叛) her partners in the Party. She was really loyal(忠诚的) to the Party. Just as Chairman Mao wrote, "a great life, a glorious death".</p>
	<p>Born in Jingle County, Gao Junyu graduated from the First Middle School of Shanxi. Then he entered Peking University and took part in the May 4 Movement of 1919. In 1921, he joined the Communist Party and became the first party member in Shanxi. He also tried to set up the Communist Youth League in Shanxi. In 1925, he died of illness and was buried in Taoranting Park.</p>
	<p>Jiao Yulu became a symbol of the honest Communist Party cadre(干部) who worked tirelessly for the people. After he joined the Party in 1946, Jiao devoted his energy to fighting poverty(贫困). As the Party leader of Lankao County, Jiao Yulu encouraged people there to fight poor conditions and helped pull the county out of poverty.</p>

Recently, many Chinese teachers depend heavily on apps to give homework. The kids have to do their homework looking at a phone screen. In a video posted on Weibo, a father criticized the teacher for grading homework in a parent-teacher WeChat group, and people discussed the topic heatedly.

Many parents support the father. They worry that looking at their mobile phones for a long time may make students' eyesight fall. Liu Yong, a 12-year-old son's father, complained, "Teenagers will have more chances to use their mobile phones to watch something unrelated(无关的) to homework so they may get distracted(分心的). Besides, they have to hand in their homework on WeChat, it also takes too much time."

However, Mrs Bai, a mother, has different opinions. She said, "Parents can understand their kids' learning situation and supervise(监督) them to finish the homework." Zhang Si, a father of two children, agrees with the mother. "The use of WeChat or QQ to give homework is convenient,"Zhang said. "It's unwise not to take advantage of technology."

Smartphone apps certainly make our lives easier though sometimes they can also cause problems. It's not necessary to refuse the apps, but we should use them carefully. In a word, apps are good, but they should not steal the show(喧宾夺主).

Recently giving homework on apps is common, and a video posted on Weibo caused heated 59.

Some parents agree with the father. 60 the students look at the phone for too long, their eyesight will be poor. They will watch something unrelated to homework and won't focus on doing their homework. Besides, students may 61 more time handing in their homework.

However, Mrs Bai and Zhang Si think 62. Parents can understand their kids' learning situation and supervise them to finish the homework, which is convenient. They think it's not a wise decision to refuse technology.

Apps are good but they should be used in a 63 way. After all, we're living in an internet era(时代).

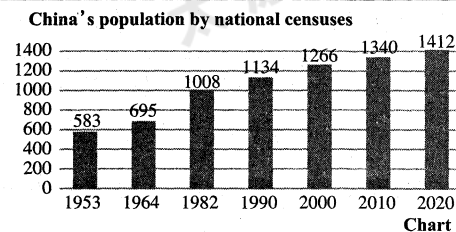

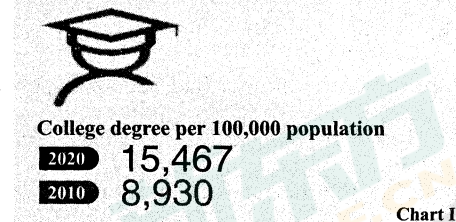
◇ World's largest population

Although there are some worries about the birthrate, the population on the mainland stands at 1.41 billion. It has been growing steadily(稳定地), and will stay above 1.4 billion for some time.



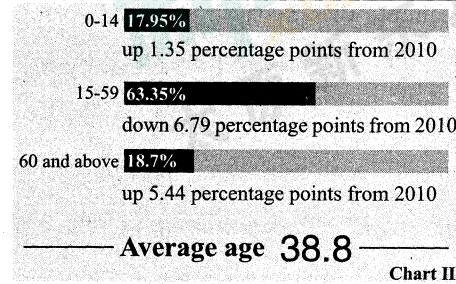
◇ More education

All school-age kids are required to go to school. And nearly 220 million people have college degrees. These young people are playing an important role in building modern society.



◇ An aging(老龄化的) society

The country's average(平均的) age is 38.8 years old. Nearly 20 percent of the people are over 60, while the number of working-age people has dropped by over 40 million. However, China is moving toward the next stage of development.



In the face of the problems caused by the aging society, some new policy decisions were made, three-child policy is one of them. That is to say, China allows couples to have three children. This marks the end of a strict two-child policy.

Many experts believe people will understand the idea of population in a more active way with the support of the three-child policy. They will come to realize that having a larger population means more social resources rather than more burdens(负担). Not only can our country benefit a lot from the new policy, but families can also live a much happier life in a harmonious society.

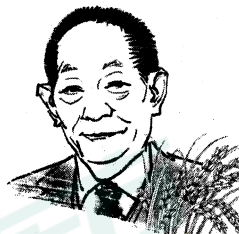

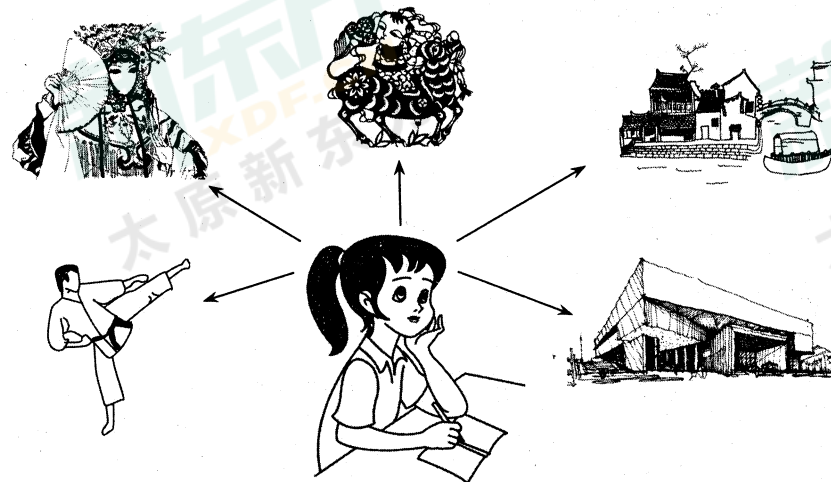
